10:15am Listen to Army/ Navy Band Performance

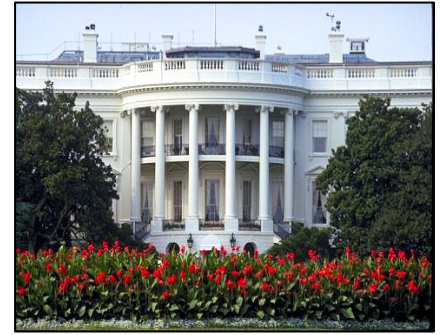
10:45am Set chairs and stands for concert
